## DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

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Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present or a work session to discuss the Towne Center Boulevard Extension proposed to be located from State Route 48 to connect with US RT 22-3 at West Street in Hamilton Township.

Mr. Tunison explained that the original plan was to let development drive when the extension would be developed but for safety concerns, he feels it is necessary to begin the improvements in advance.

Mr. Tunison reviewed the proposed alignment of the extension and presented a preliminary engineering agreement with LBJ, Inc.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #15-0406) to determine the necessity for a certain Road Improvement Project for public use without charge where special assessments are not to be levied or collected, to be known as the Towne Center Boulevard Extension (CR 2413) in Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio, and resolved (Resolution #15-0407) to enter into an Engineering Services Contract with LJB, Inc. on behalf of the Warren County Engineer.

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Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present to request the Board consider adoption of a resolution to authorize a special hauling permit for overweight and oversized vehicles for county roadways.

Mr. Tunison explained that the legal authority for the issuance of permits is within the Board of County Commissioners but is authorize approval to have his office handle the permitting, etc. on their behalf.

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Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #14-0409) to adopt a County Special Hauling Permit for Overweight and Oversized Vehicles, Developing Manual of Issuance, and Assignment of Issuance, approval and Enforcement Functions.

Skip Moorman, Timbercreek Subdivision resident, was present to congratulate the Engineer's road crews on the excellent job with snow removal during the last weather event and to also request the Board to consider lobbying the State of Ohio to limit size and amount of allowable truck traffic on State Route 123 (Alexander Hill) in the same manner they limit SR 350 towards Ft. Ancient.

Michael Yetter, Zoning Supervisor, was present along with Stan Williams, Regional Planning Commission, and Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, for a work session to discuss the conditional use permit ability within the R1A Zoning.

Commissioner South stated her concern relative to the ability to obtain a conditional use permit within a rural area to construct a 6500 square foot facility with 150 parking spaces.

Commissioner Young stated his concern relative to the dramatic change to the residential area if the Zoning Board of Appeals approves a conditional use permit under those circumstances.

Mr. Yetter explained that the application in questions is for a banquet facility. He explained that there is no table of use within the existing zoning code for that specific use. He then stated that within the zoning code is specific criterion that must be met in order for the Zoning Board of Appeals to approve a conditional use permit.

Mr. McGary reviewed the policy decision make by the Board of Commissioners in 2012 when the Board opted to include the conditional use permit as a way to encourage economic development in the "mom and pop" businesses.

There was discussion relative to the possibility of requiring an increase to the minimum lot size required for a conditional use permit.

There was also discussion relative to the difference between a conditional use permit and a Home Occupation.

Mr. McGary stated that the Zoning Board of Appeals is required to look at each specific use and decide if the requested use is appropriate.

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Upon discussion, the Board determined the need to review the specific criteria and possible amendments to the Rural Zoning Code at a later date.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:38 a.m. to discuss negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting request for economic development assistance pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(8) and exited at 11:40 a.m.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 11:40 a.m. to discuss personnel matters relative to disciplinary action within Emergency Services pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 11:50 a.m.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
