DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 9:03 a.m. to discuss imminent litigation pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(3) and exited at 9:56 a.m.

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Paul Kindell, Telecommunications Director, was present to update the Board on the possibility of the merger of Massie Township Fire and EMS with Chester Township in Clinton County.

Mr. Kindell discussed the impact of their decision as it relates to 9-1-1 dispatching as well as radio distribution and the need for a policy as it relates to funding for equipment.

The Board discussed their support of consolidation as it relates to fiscal responsibility and taxpayer savings and requested Mr. Kindell to work with the Massie Township Trustees to make them aware of all aspects associated with their merger decision.

Paul Kindell, Telecommunications Director, presented the Regional Tactical Interoperable Communications Plan (RTICP).

Mr. Kindell explained that this plan is designed to align with the National Emergency Communications Plan, the Ohio Statewide Communications Interoperability Plan, the National Response Framework and the Target Capabilities List in order to ensure comprehensive implementation of communications interoperability. He then stated that this policy is proposed to be adopted by all government agencies within the region.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #18-0300) to adopt the Regional Tactical Interoperable Communications Plan (RTICP).

Susan Spencer, Personnel Officer, discussed the hourly rate Warren County has historically paid summer help employees. She stated the hourly rate of \$9 is hindering the ability to obtain the needed employees and requested the Board consider raising the rate to \$10 per hour.

The Board agreed to Mrs. Spencer's request to raise the hourly rate for Warren County Summer Help to \$10 per hour.

Tiffany Zindel, County Administrator, presented an update on the Probate-Juvenile Court Expansion and Renovation Project.

Mrs. Zindel reviewed the reduced scope of work as proposed by the Judge as well as the revised estimate of cost for construction as well as fees.

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Upon discussion, the Board stated their desire to move forward with the proposal process in order to obtain actual costs for the project.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
