DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Martin Russell, Deputy County Administrator, was present along with Sheriff Larry Sims and staff and Gary McAnally, Wachtel & McAnally Architects/Planners, Inc. for a work session to discuss the New Warren County Jail Project.

Gary McAnally presented the attached PowerPoint presentation outlining the various options relative to size and location for the project. He stated the goal is to design the most efficient building for both cost and staffing.

Mr. McAnally presented various schemes (attached) and summarized the following:

Scheme 1 – will not fit on the existing site

Scheme 1A - smaller footprint but will still not fit on existing site

Scheme 2A - Larger portion of dorms vs. cells but still will not fit on existing site

Scheme 3A – two story building with additional construction costs due to circulation needs that will fit on existing site but allows no room for future expansion

Scheme 4A – three story building with additional construction costs but still allows no room for future expansion

Scheme 5B – add on and renovate existing jail – would require certain relocations of existing inmates and services and also require four years to complete vs. two years and an additional \$1.2 million in construction costs due to the length of construction

There was discussion relative to the various options as well as the top priority being: cost, number of beds, cost of operation and future expansion needs.

There was discussion relative to the possibility of relocation to a site not on the government campus and the additional dynamics that would come into play including transportation needs.

Upon discussion, it was determined that the various options will be reviewed with a recommendation at a later date.

Larry Ehling, Dayton, Ohio, was present to introduce himself as a democratic candidate in the 2018 primary gubernatorial election.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.


