She also stated that the funds being utilized for this grant are not tax dollars as Interact for Health is a non-profit organization.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution 19-1258) to authorize the filing of the grant application with Interact for Health for the Campaign to Reduce Stigma of Addiction Grant and authorize County Administrator to sign application.
