Tiffany Zindel, County Administrator, discussed the authorization to send a memo to elected officials, department heads and agencies receiving funding from the general fund to delay any new hiring (deemed non-essential), filling of vacancies (non-essential) and making capital purchases on discretionary items due to decrease in revenue associated with the Covid-19 pandemic.

Mrs. Zindel discussed the number one source of revenue for the county being sales tax and the number one industry being tourism. She stated her desire to assess the situation in July and make any adjustments to the request.

Upon discussion, the Board stated their approval.

There was discussion relative to the extension of the essential personnel policy as it relates to the extended stay at home order by the Ohio Department of Health.

Upon further discussion, the Board determined to continue the Essential Personnel Policy until May 1, 2020, to coincide with Ohio Department of Health amended order.
