## DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present along with Kurt Weber, Deputy County Engineer, for a work session to request the Board to create rates and charges for the County Storm Water Management District No. 1 in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 6117.

Mr. Tunison reviewed the townships included in the plan area and the desire to continue the rate at \$12 for each parcel with building values greater than \$10,000.00, the same rate for the last five (5) years.

Mr. Tunison stated that the funds are used to administer the Warren County Storm Water Management Plan as filed with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency under conditions of the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II Permit. He stated that the townships that are part of the plan are Clearcreek, Franklin, Hamilton, Turtlecreek, and Union Townships.

Mr. Tunison then reviewed the plan activities which include public education and outreach. He clarified that this fee is only for program money and a new fee would need to be created, which couldn't be an income tax assessment, to provide for construction dollars.

There was discussion relative to the potential need for any future construction projects due to aging subdivision drainage systems.

Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, stated the county does not have the easements or responsibility to repair any private drainage issues. He then discussed the responsibility of a homeowner's association for drainage problems.

Upon discussion, the Board closed this discussion.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, stated his desire for the Board to consider continuing the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) for the Miami Valley Gaming in Monroe and Turtlecreek Township in order to fund future road improvements relative to Gateway Boulevard.

The Board stated they have no problem extending the TIF for needed roadway improvements relative to the Racino.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
